Saturday 6 February 2021

Departing from Te Atatu Peninsula Bowling Club to all Bowling venues at 7:00am. All private vehicles / shuttles will travel direct to destinations from their ACCOMMODATION to the various Bowling Clubs.

Transport leaves all venues **at approx. 6.30pm AFTER DINNER** returning to Headquarters, Te Atatu Peninsula.

Sunday 7 February 2021

Departing from Te Atatu Peninsula direct to bowling club venues at 6:30 am All private vehicles / shuttles will travel direct to destinations from their ACCOMMODATION to the varius Bowling Clubs.

Shuttle Vans leave all venues **at approx. 12.30pm** (after lunch) returning to Headquarters. Te Atatu Peninsula

PLEASE NOTE: The **top two** place getters in each of the **Flights Sections** must be at Headquarters (Te Atatu Peninsula Bowling Club) for a **1.30pm start**. Trial ends available from 1.15pm and must be completed before start of play.

Transport can be arranged with the Transport Coodinator:

- From headquarters back to accommodation in the evening

If you require transport to bowls on Saturday or Sunday morning, it must be booked with the Transport Coordinator at Headquarters before 8pm on the night before
