CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. **Laws and Regulations:** Played under the Laws of the Sport of Bowls and Bowls New Zealand Domestic Regulations as applicable.
2. **Controlling Body:** The Controlling Body for this tournament is Bowls North Harbour. The Controlling Body will have the right to alter, add to or delete any conditions of play and / or special conditions to enable the completion of the event.
3. **Composition of Sides:** Sides of 8 players with the playing format of 2 Fours teams, 4 Pairs teams and 8 Singles players. Substitutions are permitted, with up to two players for both the men and the women being included in the teams.
4. **Covid 19:** Bowls North Harbour has made an in principle decision to only hold Centre events at venues that have adopted the Government's vaccine certificate regime policy. In addition, it is expected that each Centre will only select players who are fully vaccinated against Covid-19 to represent the Centre.
5. **Clothing:** Players in a team will be in matching uniforms. Appropriate footwear, as per the Laws of the Sport of Bowls – Domestic Regulations 11.1, is to be worn.
6. **Contact between players:** At the beginning of the game and the end of the game the Controlling body have recommended that physical contact between players is no longer encouraged.
7. **No Smoking Policy:** Cigarettes, e-cigarettes and vaping are all banned anywhere in the clubhouse and on the greens. Club has designated 'smoking area(s)' to be used by players and officials.
8. **Alcohol:** The drinking of alcohol is to be confined to the club house. Drinking outside of the clubhouse during competitions will not be permitted.
9. **Advice by Coach:** The Coach, or their appointed substitute, can give advice to a player in their side during the course of the competition, in accordance with the Laws of the Sport of Bowls. The names of the Team Manager(s) and Team Coach(es) must be handed to the convenor before the commencement of play.
10. **The Draw:** Before play begins for each discipline, overall Team Captains for each side will draw teams/players to determine who plays who in each round of the competition.
11. **Time Limit:** In all games there will be a time limit of Two hours and 30 minutes (2 ½ hours). All games to be continued irrespective of the score until the designated time limit is over or until the game is finished, whichever comes first. If the jack has been delivered before the time signal the end will continue and if it subsequently becomes dead it will be replayed.
12. **Format:** All games will be played under the traditional format as below:
 - Singles: 4 bowls; 21 Shots or 2 ½ hours – whichever comes first
 - Pairs: 3 bowls each; 18 Ends or 2 ½ hours – whichever comes first
 - Fours: 2 bowls each; 15 Ends or 2 ½ hours – whichever comes first
13. **Trial Ends:** Prior to the start of the first game each player will be allowed two trial ends.
14. **Restricting the Movement of Players:** In all games, the movement of players during play shall be restricted as follows:
 - Singles: after delivery of their third and fourth bowls.
 - Pairs:
 - Leads: after delivery of their third bowl
 - Skips: after delivery of each bowl

Fours:

Leads: after delivery of their second bowl

Twos: after delivery of their second bowl

Threes: after delivery of their second bowl

Skips: after delivery of each bowl

15. **Determining a winner:** In all games one point will be awarded for each game won and half a point for each game drawn. Where game points are equal, the winner will be the team with the highest net total of shots. If the game points and the net total of shots are equal, the team with the lowest “total shots against” will be the winner. **Points will be awarded for the men’s competition, women’s competition plus points for the 1-5 year men’s and women’s competitions for the overall result.**

16. **Variations to Conditions of Play:** In the event of inclement weather, or any other extraordinary circumstances, the Controlling Body may vary the Conditions of Play by reducing the number of ends and/or time limit of any game; or reducing the number of games. Any decision made must be prior to the commencement of a game.

17. **Inclement Weather:** If play is stopped due to weather conditions, the following shall constitute a game:

Singles: 15 shots

Pairs: 9 ends

Fours: 7 ends

An end that is still in progress when the bell rings shall be cleared and will not be counted.

18. **The Jury of Appeal:** will consist of one representative from Auckland and one from North Harbour.
